# **Cooperative Annual Report**

- -William reviewed a color booklet showing the report of the cooperative's year
- -increase in new members- really pushing membership
- -reusable bag program: discussion about the money raised for charities (Lauren asked about getting press on this program, since Ever'man is the only place that does this program)
- -discussion of sales of local, sales of fair-trade (local number is high because everything made in the deli is considered local)
- -store display reports- won award for two employees to go to Cascadia Farm and another won money that was split between marketing and grocery departments
- -report of balance sheet (decrease is showing due to purchase of property on 9 Mile Road) total assets has increased
- -discussion of net operating income
- -showing preliminary 2016 net income of \$262,293
- -waiting on one statement of patronage dividend check from NCG (National Cooperative Grocers) which will affect the final numbers slightly

William gave each board member a copy of the <u>employee monthly newsletter</u>, pointing out Dave's article about what the board does/is

# **Expansion Report:**

William reported that we have received 2<sup>nd</sup> plan from the DC

- -our local architect sees some changes to be made
- -William meeting with architect tomorrow
- -William met with DOT about entrances and exits- but he feels better about the options now for turn lanes, etc. than he did after the initial meeting
- -Hugh Ed asked if the co-op covers these lane expenses- William answered yes
- -Eric brought up making sure area is checked for gopher tortoises
- -Kelly asked when drawings would be available
- ---William answered how there are some challenges with the layout of the truck dock, deli seating area, etc.
- ---Looking at glass extension on backside to widen the area
- ---once the seating area is worked out, drawings will become available
- -A lot of civil work has to be done- different from the work on the current store location

Lynn attended the Cooperative Conference this summer- she reported about presentations she attended

Michael Sansolo- keynote speaker- spoke about e-commerce, Blue Apron, etc.

- -William spoke about working on getting a display case that can house the frozen, cold and dry goods for a recipe

- -catchphrase from Wegman's grocery- employee said "You're worth it"
